


There are a wide variety of alternative modes of transportation available at USF that can help you get to, from, and around campus without having to use a single occupancy vehicle.

Alternative Transportation at the University of South Florida



The USF Bull Runner Transit System provides FARE-FREE transportation around the campus and locations off-campus including the University Mall, a local grocery store, and off-campus apartment complexes, seven days a week for USF students and employees. The Share-A-Bull Bikes program, operated by Campus Recreation at USF, makes bikes available for shared use on a short-term basis on the USF Tampa campus. Register for the program at no cost at usf.socialbicycles.com today!

Here is how it works:

- 1) Reserve:** Find and reserve a bike using our mobile app (app.socialbicycles.com), in the Share-A-Bull browser (usf.socialbicycles.com), or on the bicycle itself.
- 2) Release:** Once you've reserved a ride, just enter your 4-digit PIN code on the bike's keypad to unlock it. Remember to ride safely and follow safety rules.
- 3) Ride!** Want to stop for coffee? Press the "HOLD" button and lock the bike to any bike rack. Just enter your 4-digit PIN to unlock and continue riding.
- 4) Return:** To end your trip, just lock your bike at a Share-A-Bull hub location or at any regular bike rack around the campus.



Enterprise CarShare - Students may rent a car by the hour through the Enterprise CarShare program. The program offers an automated way to rent a vehicle by the hour, day or overnight. A variety of cars are available on campus. The rental rate includes physical damage and liability protection for ages 18 and up. For more information, visit: enterprisecarshare.com

The USF Carpool Program

provides participants who meet the program's eligibility requirements with discounted parking permit pricing, reserved carpool parking spaces. Other benefits include free membership in the Emergency Ride Home (ERH) program, free rideshare online matching through the Tampa Bay Area Regional Transportation Authority (TBARTA) and three free one-day parking permits per semester.

HART (The Hillsborough Area Regional Transit Authority) - USF students showing a valid USF I.D. can ride HART Local, Limited Express, MetroRapid and Flex routes FARE-FREE. USF faculty and staff pay just 50¢ with their valid USF I.D. Connections between HART and USF's Bull Runner Transit are available at the HART University Area Transit Center.
